

The aviation industry and the whole world faces a huge challenge right now. Since the beginning of the COVID-19 outbreak, Simnest Pilot Academy has been proactively taking measures to ensure the safety of its students, employees and their families, while ensuring the continuity of its operations.

The following measures have been taken:

- A form is displayed at the entrance to emphasize and remind the importance of hand washing and correct way of coughing, sneezing and nose-blowing
- No large group meetings and theory classes at Simnest Pilot Academy
- Only fever-free individuals without symptoms of COVID-19 may participate in the training
- No handshakes are allowed
- Hand sanitizer and facilities for hand-washing are provided at the premises
- Usage of hand sanitizer is obligatory before entering the simulator
- A mask which covers the mouth and nose must be worn at the premises
- Maximum 3 students and 1 instructor are allowed in the simulator at the same time
- Keeping safe distance (1.5 m) between each person is obligatory outside the simulator
- Simnest Pilot Academy has implemented strict cleaning and disinfecting protocols for its facilities, which will be maintained as long as it is required
- Before the first training starts and at each change of personnel (including switching seating positions), the main controls of the simulator and frequently touched objects (door handles, light switches etc.) are wiped with an alcohol swab for sanitisation
- The premises are ventilated before and after each training session and during breaks
- The usage of headsets, microphones and especially oxygen masks are strictly forbidden until further notice
- Training documents must be filled out with owned writing tools. Giving writing tools to others must be avoided.
